Lent 2025

Lent is a time we focus on 3 things: Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving. Below are some Lenten ideas/challenges for our RE kids & families this year:

PRAY

Once a week this Lent, say a prayer in church for the students of Fr. Ssonko's St. Mary's School in Uganda. You can say a prayer in your own words or a prayer you have memorized. You can stop in and say it sometime during the week, or before or after Mass on the weekend.

FAST

This Lent, think of the things the students in Uganda don't have that you do: things like snacks, candy, and pop. Maybe you can give up pop or candy for all of Lent. Maybe you can give up one snack a day, or no snacks on Friday or some other day each week. When you feel hungry for the snacks, pop, or candy that you gave up: imagine how the things we can have so easily are not available to so many children in the world.

GIVE

It costs \$1 per week to feed one student at St. Mary's School. For Lent, you can give \$6 to help feed one student for the 6 weeks of Lent. This can come from your allowance, or you can do extra chores at home to earn some money to donate. If moms and dads or others in your family want to donate, they can, too!
